Obamacare Sparks Government Shutdown

Last Monday night, on September 30, Congress found itself in a very sensitive situation between the Democrats and the Republicans. This situation came to a head last week due to disagreements on the Patient Protection

and Affordable Care Act (commonly known as Obamacare), a government policy that aims to provide access to discounted health care for all Americans. Obamacare allows for affordable health care, gives 19 to 25 year olds the ability to stay on their parents' health care, and permits those with pre-existing conditions to receive treatment,

with no prejudice towards gender or age.

However, Republicans oppose this policy due to the 2% tax increase for all who do not use it and the increase in prescription costs, amounting to an additional \$84.8 billion in fees over the next ten years (CNN). This policy already began to take effect, but SEE "SHUTDOWN" PAGE 2
